## 100 Years Since Fatima

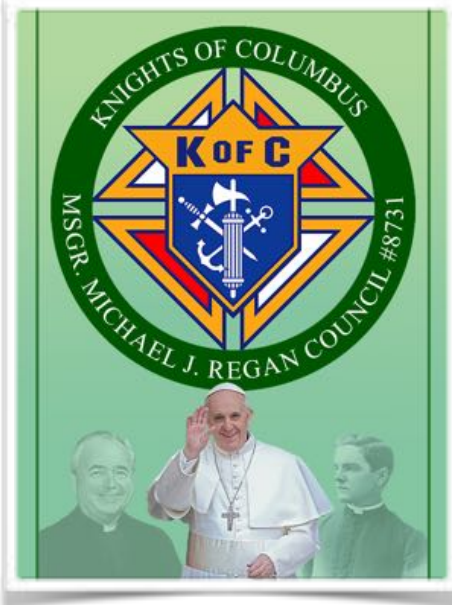
